- D. Loss Control Specialist Report- The Risk Management Activity Report was included in the kit with the safety meetings, trainings and onsite inspections that were completed since the last meeting. Bill Ruch introduced Jim Philbin who joined the Fund as part of the loss control team. Jim's focus will be law enforcement and he will service members located in South Jersey towns. Bill noted water sensors are available through Chubb for Fund members. These sensors can be placed in buildings or areas of potential exposure and can alert the town if a leak or problem occurs.
